**Taiyo Yuden to Acquire the Communications Device Business  
of Fujitsu Media Devices, Making it a Subsidiary Company**

TOKYO, December 17, 2009 — Taiyo Yuden Co., Ltd. announced that it has executed a three-party agreement with Fujitsu Limited and its wholly owned subsidiary Fujitsu Media Devices Limited to acquire the latter's communications device business. Details were previously identified in a press release dated September 28, 2009.

**1. Method of Business Acquisition**

Taiyo Yuden plans to acquire the communications device business of Fujitsu Media Devices by the following method.

- (1) Fujitsu Media Devices will spin off into a newly established separate subsidiary company its communication device business.
- (2) Taiyo Yuden will acquire from Fujitsu Media Devices all of the issued and outstanding shares of the newly established separate company.

**2. Number of Shares to be Acquired and the Acquisition Price**

A final decision with regard to the number of shares to be acquired and the acquisition price will be determined through consultation between Taiyo Yuden, Fujitsu and Fujitsu Media Devices based on the value of assets and liabilities to be acquired on the date of spin off.

**3. Schedule**

Looking ahead, steps will be taken to push forward with all necessary procedural requirements in connection with the acquisition of the subject business. The acquisition is scheduled for completion on March 31, 2010.
