Second Report on Measures to Prevent the Spread of Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19)

Tokyo, April 1, 2020 Based on its business continuity plan (BCP), TAIYO YUDEN is implementing a range of measures to prevent the spread of the novel coronavirus and ensure the health and safety of its employees, business partners and other stakeholders.

As part of these measures, we already asked our employees at the head office (Chuo-ku, Tokyo) to work from home, in principle, on March 30 and 31, in response to the recent spread of the novel coronavirus and the request of the Japanese government and the Tokyo Metropolitan Government based on their novel coronavirus infection control policies.

We have decided to extend the abovementioned period until April 6, and also request those at sales offices in Osaka, Nagoya and Fukuoka to telework from March 31 to April 3, as a general rule. Those whose work requires them to be on site are asked to take thorough infection control measures, including staggered commuting to avoid peak hours.
