



- ◆Operating Current (Verification of Rated current)
 - 1. The operating current including inrush current for inductors must always be lower than their rated values.
 - 2. Do not apply current in excess of the rated value because the inductance may be reduced due to the magnetic saturation effect.
- ◆Temperature rise

Temperature rise of power choke coil depends on the installation condition in end products.

Make sure that temperature rise of power choke coils in actual end products is within the specified temperature range.


